Licensing and Credentialing

- Over the past five years, the DPD program has had 88 students take the R.D. exam, with 78 passing on the first attempt. (89.2% first time pass rate)
- Over the past five years, the Dietetic Intern program has had 50 students take the R.D. exam with 47 passing on the first attempt. (94.0% first time pass rate)
- Over the past five years, 56 Family and Consumer Science Teacher Education candidates have sat for the Assessment of Professional Teaching (APT) test and 56 have passed. (100% pass rate)
- The department has an overall pass rate of 93.9% on licensing exams.
