This sample plan assumes students transfer with an A.S. or A.A. degree or having met IAI requirements.

It is strongly recommended that courses articulating to Illinois State University as **ECO 105**; **CHE 110** and **112**; and the Global Studies (Non-Western) course requirement be completed prior to transferring as they are not included in this plan of study.

Courses articulating as **ACC 131**, **BSC 160**, **FCS 102** and **MQM 100** are offered at most community colleges and a food preparation course that can be substituted for **FCS 113** may also be offered. Completion of some of these courses prior to transferring will allow room for more suggested electives and senior college hours. The bachelor's degree requires at least 42 semester hours senior college hours, 200- and 300-level courses taken at four year college or university. This plan only includes 38 hours.

Suggested electives at Illinois State University include: AGR 201, 203, 271, 285; FIL 185; MKT 230, 231
