- Over the past three years, the Didactic Program in Dietetics has had 78 students take the RD exam with 66 passing within the first year of taking the exam. (85%)

- Over the past five years, Family and Consumer Science Teacher Education candidates that have sat for the Educational Teacher Performance Assessment (edTPA) test have passed with a 100% pass rate.
